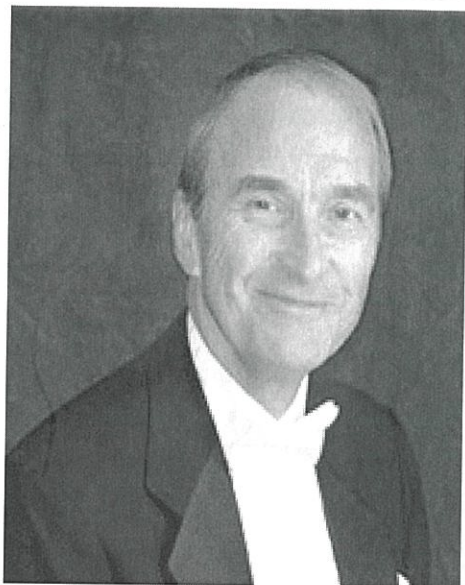

## Robert Halseth, Wind Studies

Robert Halseth has been Director of Wind Studies and Professor of Music at California State University, Sacramento since 1993. He conducts the Symphonic Wind Ensemble and Concert Band, teaches conducting, and is the founder and co-clinician of the Summer Wind Conducting Workshop, now in its 16th year. He holds BA and MA degrees in music from California State University, Fresno, and a Doctor of Arts degree in wind conducting and brass pedagogy from the

University of Northern Colorado.

He has taught/conducted instrumental music at all levels, elementary through professional. Since 1981 he has been at the college/university level, serving on the music faculties of Carroll College (Waukesha, Wisconsin) and University of the Pacific (Stockton, California) prior to accepting his present position at Sacramento State in 1993.

Dr. Halseth has conducted in Carnegie Hall and the Mondavi Center, and led performances at conferences of the California Band Directors Association, California Music Educators Association, Colorado Music Educators Association, College Band Directors National Association, and International Trombone Association. From 1992-1999 he led the Stockton Concert Band, taking them on a London tour in 1997. His 40-year career as a bass trombonist includes membership in the National Repertory Orchestra, San Diego Symphony, and countless professional groups.

Professional memberships include WASBE, CBDA, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Kappa Kappa Psi and Pi Kappa Lambda, and he is Past President of the Western Division of the College Band Directors National Association.



## Don Tsuha

Born and raised in Hawai'i, Don Tsuha is a graduate of Roosevelt High School in Honolulu. He continued his education at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa, receiving his Bachelor of Education (1975), Professional (Education) Diploma (1979), and Master of Music Education (1999) degrees. He is a member of *Pi Kappa Lambda* National Music Honor Society.

His 32 years of teaching experience with the State of Hawai'i Department of Education began at Waimanalo Elementary and Intermediate School (1976 – 77). He moved to the DOE Central District to continue teaching at Wheeler Middle School (1977 – 1980). After three years, he transferred to Moanalua Middle School where he taught from 1980 until his retirement from teaching in the summer of 2008. During his tenure at Moanalua Middle School, he took leave of a year and a half to serve as co-director of the Central District Gifted and Talented Band with Mr. Hajime Kuwada. After retiring from the Department of Education, he has served as a substitute lecturer at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa, teaching the undergraduate Brass Methods course for two semesters.

He has served as guest conductor of the Maui Intermediate School Massed and Select Bands, the Maui High School Massed Band, and other school bands on Maui and Oahu.

His past professional organization memberships include the Hawai'i Music Educators Association, Hawai'i State Band Directors, and the American School Band Directors Association. He has served as Chair of the Central District Band Festival on three occasions.
