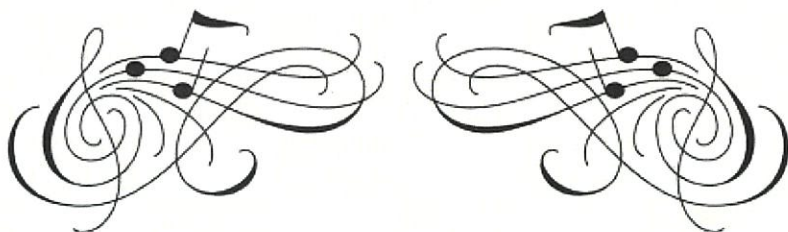

The purpose of the festival is:

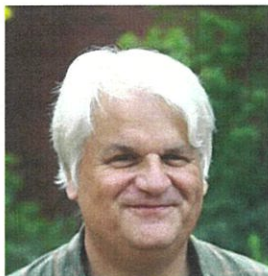
1. To give the band programs in the Central District an opportunity to demonstrate to the community, student achievement through authentic performance and standard based assessment.
2. To bring into closer relations the band directors in the district so that they can exchange musical and educational ideas. This relationship will help to assist in the overall betterment of the band programs in the district.
3. To provide an unbiased and professional evaluation of each band. Thereby giving the directors and students tangible evidence on their programs achievements as it relates to the HCPS III.
4. To learn new techniques and concepts from the clinicians, which will in turn help improve the quality of music education in the schools.

The goals of the festival are:

1. To bring music to the community we serve.
2. To allow the bandsmen opportunities to share musical experiences.
3. To provide for the exchange of musical ideas amongst the band directors in the district.
4. This cooperation will assist in the betterment of the band programs within the district.
5. To provide visible evidence of the instrumental music programs in the communities.
6. To provide bandsmen and masters with new techniques and greater musical input through the expertise provide by the clinicians.



## MR. ROBERT PONTO



Robert Ponto is the Assistant Dean for Admissions at the University of Oregon School of Music and Dance. Prior to this appointment he served as Director of Bands for 20 years. He has conducted ensembles through the United States, Canada, and the United Kingdom. His performing ensembles have been featured at the Bang on a Can contemporary music festival in New York, on National Public Radio, Oregon Public Radio, and have appeared regularly at state, regional and national music conferences.

A self-described “musical omnivore,” Ponto is an advocate for original music in all genres and is actively engaged in the creation and performance of new works. He has collaborated with many influential composers including John Adams, Steven Stucky, Michael Daugherty, Gia Kancheli, Frank Ticheli, Scott Lindroth, Augusta Read Thomas, David Crumb, and many others. He conducted the world premiere of Justine F. Chen’s *Philomel* with soprano Lucy Shelton and a soon-to-be-released recording of David Crumb’s *Primordial Fantasy*, with pianist Marcantonio Barone.

As an electronic music and sound design hobbyist, Ponto has contributed to unique projects in that genre as well. The contemporary music ensemble, Beta Collide has performed his *Postmark Sirius: In Memoriam Karlheinz Stockhausen* for trumpet and live electronics, *Beta Bacher* (for the Oregon Bach Festival’s *Bach Remix V*), and a digital realization of Stockhausen’s *Solo*. His sound design work was also used by British pop singer/songwriter Imogen Heap on her song, “Lifeline,” for the album, *Sparks*.



## DR. ADAM KEHL



Dr. Adam Kehl serves as Associate Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Music at the University of Hawai'i at Manoa, where he conducts the symphonic band and concert band, directs the Rainbow Warrior Marching Band, and teaches courses in music education. He previously served as Director of Bands at Elon University in Elon, NC, conducting the wind ensemble and chamber winds, directing the marching and basketball bands, teaching courses in music education and advising undergraduate research projects. Originally from the Pacific Northwest, Dr. Kehl holds Bachelor of Music degrees in Music Education and Percussion Performance from the University of Oregon, a Master of Music in conducting from the University of New Mexico, and a Doctorate of Musical Arts in conducting from the University of South Carolina. He previously served as a high school band director in the public schools of California and is highly active as a clinician, adjudicator, guest conductor and music arranger for concert and marching bands around the United States.

A keen advocate for new music, media integration, creative programming and inter-arts collaboration, some of Dr. Kehl's recent projects include, "A Little Song and Dance," a collaboration with the Elon Dance Program, and "Mozart in Popular Culture," an exploration of the use of Mozart's "Gran Partita" in television and film. He has worked with such guests artists as Dr. David Constantine from the US "Presidents' Own" Marine Band, Dr. Nave Graham, founding member of the All of the Above Ensemble, Lynn and Dr. John Beck, and Elon University President Dr. Leo Lambert. Dr. Kehl is actively involved in bringing new works to life through commissioning and conducting premieres, including works by Donald Grantham, Kevin Walczyk, David Clay Mettens, Carter Pann, Adrienne Albert, Todd Coleman, Ted King-Smith, David Kirkland Garner, Nick Omiccioli, and Aaron Perrine.

Dr. Kehl holds memberships in the College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, and NAFME.


